Sub: ECM Closure Module in ECCS - reg.

1. At present the report on open ECM lines is already available in ECCS to respective Customs officers for regular monitoring of the consignments in Customs area.
2. The feedback received from Customs formations suggested that a facility for recording the status as well as action taken on open ECM lines and the facility to manually close open ECM lines may also be available to them for further effective monitoring of the consignments.
3. Now, a module has been made available in the ECCS under AC/DC role where entries can be made on the status/action taken on each of the open lines. The user manual on the new module is enclosed along with this advisory. The Officer is required to select the particular ECMs. The list of open lines will be made available to the officer under the ECM and officer would be able to click on each open line to see/update further details. Comments on action taken can be added by the officers at different stages.
4. Necessary steps may be taken for effective implementation of this module. In case of any difficulties in using this module or any feedback on further enhancements needed in this module, the same may be brought to the notice of Systems, WZU, Mumbai, via email at systems.wzumumbai@gov.in
