ADVISORY NO. 06/SYS/WZU/2021

Sub: Integration of ECCS with IDPMS / EDPMS of RBI- reg.

- 1. This advisory is issued in continuance to Advisory No. 05/SYS/WZU/2021 dated 20.07.2021 issued on the above subject.
- 2. The Courier Bills of Entry (CBEs) and Courier Shipping Bills (CSBs) data shall be transmitted online from ECCS to RBI systems via ICEGATE. This integration will assist the exporters and importers to ensure online and hassle free compliance of Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and Foreign Exchange Management (Current Account Transaction) Rules, 2000.
- 3. The Authorised Dealer Code (AD code) is an essential field for monitoring of remittances by RBI. Facility for online registration of AD codes is already available on ICEGATE. To guide the trade, an advisory explaining the process is available on the ICEGATE portal (https://icegate.gov.in/Download/AD Code Bank Account Registration Advisory Final.pdf).
- 4. In order to further enhance 'Trade Facilitation' and ensure 'Ease of Doing Business', it is hereby clarified that:
 - i. The integration of ECCS with IDPMS / EDPMS of RBI is planned to be launched in a phased manner.
 - ii. The declaration of AD code in the CBE/CSB shall be optional in this initial phase.
 - iii. In this initial phase of launch of this module, the processing of CBEs / CSBs shall not be stopped in ECCS, even if AD code is not registered in ICEGATE.
 - iv. The importer or exporter, whose AD code is already registered in ACC location, having same port code as that of ICT, are not required to get themselves separately registered.
 - v. In order to give sufficient time for the trade to register their AD code on ICEGATE portal, the AD code validation will be introduced later after readiness of trade is ascertained.
 - vi. The ECCS integration with IDPMS / EDPMS shall be done on the same lines, as being done already in ICES.
- 5. Thus, it is advised that all the exporters and importers should register their AD codes on ICEGATE. In case of any difficulty in implementation of this module or any other related issues, it is requested to email on icegatehelpdesk@icegate.gov.in
